The third Advisa series cross country series races took place last Saturday at St. Ouen's Manor. The club and sponsors would like to thank Mrs. De Carteret for allowing the race to take place at short notice as this venue is one of the most popular in the series. Early rain had died away leaving a pleasant sunny autumn afternoon allowing the course to be flagged early on. The route took a steep rise from the car park before turning left through the woods. At the end of the woods another left turn took a steep descent down to the pond which was looped around taking the runners along the bottom of the manor, up some steep steps. A right turn this time took the competitors up the grass verge to the manor entrance and then finally a u-turn and quick descent down the manor road back to the start. In all the course was just shy of 1 kilometre. Another good turnout saw ninety six runners complete the course.

The 7/8 age group was the first race under way with the runners completing one lap of the course. There were several fallers in this race as the runners came down the slope to the pond and losing their footing when turning left. Scott Le Moucheux gained revenge from by beating last month's winner, Edward Jeffries, by a clear six seconds. There was a close finish for third place with Adam Kennedy holding off Callum Cuthbert for third place. Elizabeth Atkinson made in three wins out of three when she led home Hannah Worth by ten seconds. Abbie Inman came past Holly Masefield at the finish to take third place,

In the 9/10 age group the competitors completed two laps of the circuit. In the girl's race Lucy Hunt again made in three wins in three races with an outstanding race in winning from Lucy Scott by sixteen seconds. Molly McCready took third place from Katie Le Rougetel. A well judged race saw Oliver Rothwell pull away from Luke Harris and Jakob Stanton to win by seven seconds.

The senior boys and girls ran three laps of the track in preparation for the forthcoming Hampshire trials. There were good wins for Jack Kennedy in the Boys 12/12 age group, Adele Maher in the girls 11/12 age group and Florence Gothard in the girls 13/14 age group.

After the race Advisa Group medals were given to the first three home in each age group and lucky race numbers were drawn for six cinema ticket spot prizes.
